History comes alive at this beautifully preserved, early 20th-century prairie homestead. Explore the iconic stone house and historic barns while walking in the footsteps of W.R. Motherwell, a pioneer of scientific farming. You can watch costumed guides demonstrate historic farming techniques, interact with heritage livestock, and enjoy the sights and sounds of a bustling turn-of-the-century farmyard.
